

RAISE YOUR VOICE: SAY YES TO INCLUSION!

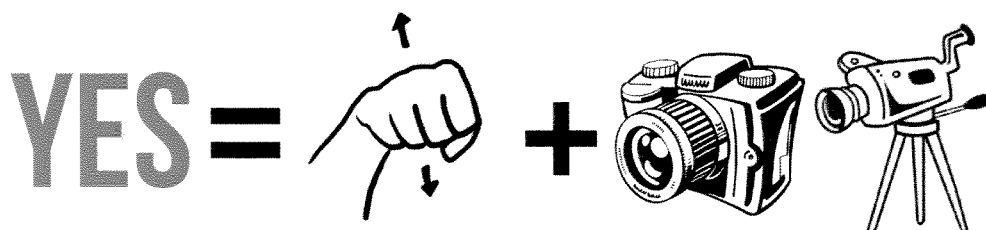
